

## An Active day out

Sitting comfortably at the foot of the Black Mountains with the River Wye nearby, Talgarth is a perfectly positioned outdoor playground and no break here would be complete without trying out at least one of the amazing range of activities on offer – from beginner to seasoned professional – there is something here for everybody. Many of the activities may require booking in advance, please check before you arrive. Much information is freely available on the internet, your accommodation provider or the Talgarth Information and Resource Centre.

Within a short distance of Talgarth you can choose:

**Hill walking** – pick up a copy of “Walks around Talgarth” from Talgarth Tourist Information & Resource Centre.

**Mountain Biking** – Pick up a copy of “Mountain Biking Brecon Beacons”, there are 3 routes starting from the car park, one of which is the only Black route in the National Park. Or hire a bike from Drover Holidays or Bikes & Hikes.

**Horse Riding** – there are several trekking centres nearby, Tregoyd Mountain Riders at Three Cocks, Ellesmere Riding Centre and Llangors Riding Centre at Llangors and Trans Wales Trails riding at Pengenffordd.

**Water sports and Fishing** – Llangors Lake is perfect or if it is game fishing, the Rivers Wye and Usk are nearby.

**Gliding** – Talgarth is home to the Black Mountain Gliding Club, trial lessons are bookable.

**Indoor climbing & high ropes centre**– Llangors Activity Centre is just a few miles away.

**Black Mountain Activity Centre** – This is an outdoor centre specialising in caving, canoeing, white water rafting and much more.

So no excuses – book your activity, plan your picnic and return to Talgarth for an evening meal and don't forget to ask for a local brew. So what are you waiting for!

### Opening Hours

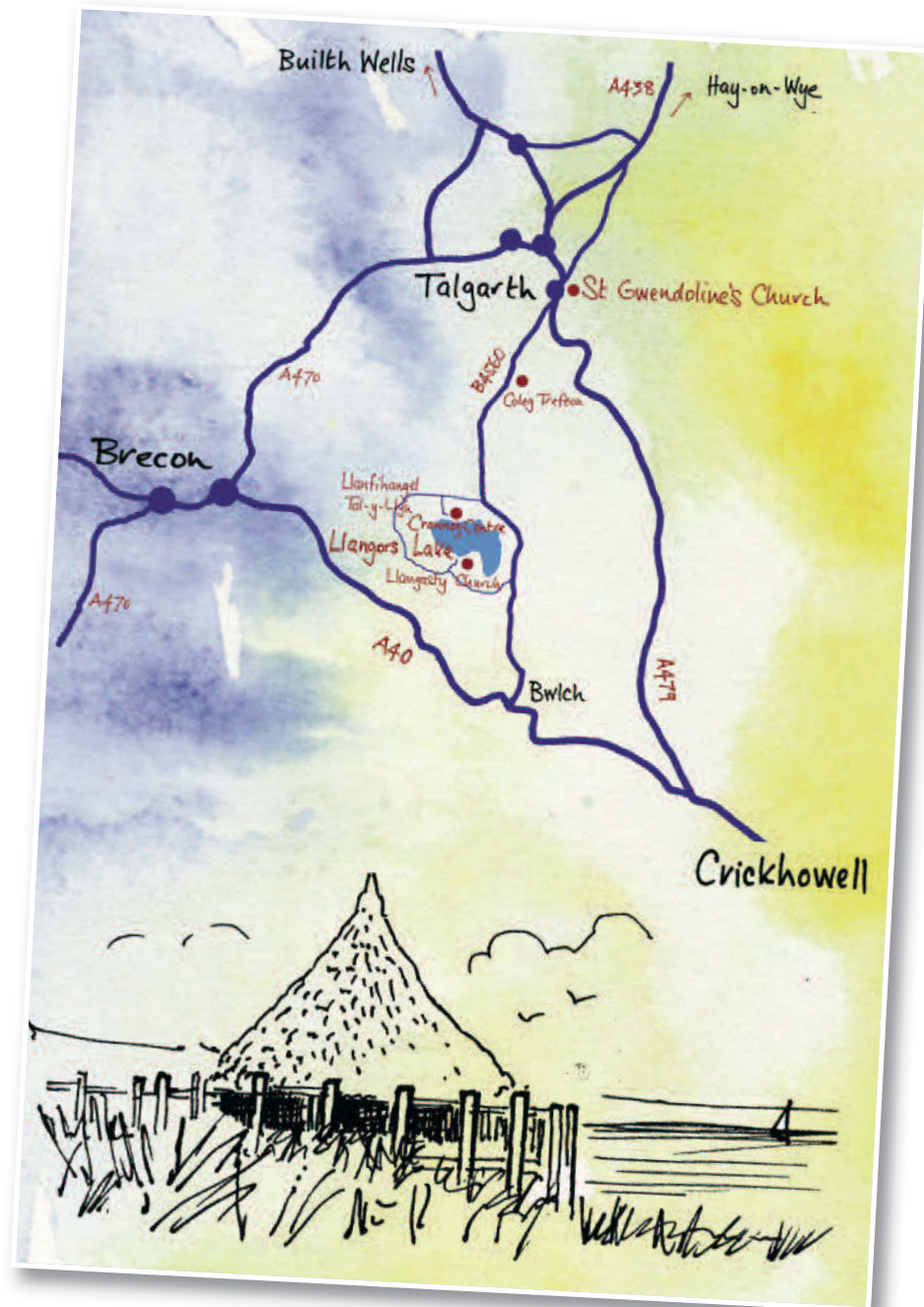
**Summer** Monday to Saturday – 10.00am to 4.00pm. Sunday 10.00am – to 1.00pm

## Public Transport

**By Train** the nearest station is Abergavenny – Talgarth is 18 miles from Abergavenny  
**By bus:** Talgarth is serviced by buses in all directions, from Hereford, Builth Wells, Abergavenny and Brecon. Look at [www.traveline-cymru.org.uk](http://www.traveline-cymru.org.uk) for the latest travel information and

timetables. For the Hereford to Brecon (via Talgarth) bus timetable, search for Service 39 on the Herefordshire County Council website (39a for the Sunday timetable). During the summer months the Beacons Bus service also passes through Talgarth on Sundays and Bank Holiday Mondays from the end of May to the beginning of October.
